

uni-FLIST

File System Management Utility

uni-FLIST is a Unix file system management utility patterned after the FLIST utility found in the VM/CMS environment. uni-FLIST helps users manage Unix files more easily by providing a full screen display of files in a directory and allowing users to direct commands to specific files through the use of PF keys.

IMPORTANT: There are several capabilities present in the VM/CMS version of FLIST that are not available in the current release of uni-FLIST. The functionality of uni-FLIST may be extended in the future.

Using uni-FLIST

The uni-FLIST file must be placed in your current working directory or in a directory specified in your PATH environment variable. You may start the program in any of the following ways:

```
flist [-a] [-m <pattern>] [<directory>]
```

-a	display all files
-m <pattern>	display files matching 'pattern'
<directory>	display files in named directory

Examples:

```
flist
```

displays files in the current directory

```
flist -m 'c*'
```

displays files beginning with c in the current directory

```
flist -a test
```

displays all files in the test directory only

Once the file listing is displayed, the following PF keys may be used:

F1	Help
F2	Execute file at cursor position
F3	Exit uni-FLIST
F4	Invoke uni-XEDIT (if present) to edit file at cursor position
F7	Scroll display up
F8	Scroll display down
F9	Sort display by date (equivalent to ;sd)

In addition to the use of PF keys in uni-FLIST, you may press Enter or type a command from the list below.

Enter	change directory
;h	output help text
;a	toggle 'all' option
;p	exit to parent directory
;sd	sort display by date
;sn	sort display by file name
;ss	sort display by file size
;m pattern	reset file name pattern
=	execute last command

You may also use file name substitution characters when specifying file names for file maintenance commands.

;	insert same file name
::	insert same file name with concatenation
;o	omit same file name
;n	insert same file name up to last period

TERMINFO Definitions

uni-FLIST is a System V curses application and responds to the following TERMINFO key definitions:

curses.h	TERMINFO	Function (as described above)
KEY_F2	kf2=	execute
KEY_F3	kf3=	end
KEY_F4	kf4=	uni-XEDIT
KEY_F7	kf7=	scroll up
KEY_F8	kf8=	scroll down
KEY_DOWN	kcud1=	cursor down
KEY_UP	kcuu1=	cursor up
KEY_LEFT	kcub1=	cursor left
KEY_RIGHT	kcuf1=	cursor right
KEY_ENTER	kent=	cd or execute entered command

The TERMINFO keys may work differently on your system

**EDITOR
Environment
Variable**

uni-FLIST uses the EDITOR environment variable to determine which editor to use. If EDITOR is not set, the string "xe" is used. "xe" must also be in your PATH.
