

# **uni-XEDIT 2.15**

## **Now Shipping**

We are please to announce the availability of release 2.15 of uni-XEDIT for Solaris, AIX, HP/UX, NCR, SGI, and Linux. This release is available by download from our website, or by calling Sales at 800 228 0255.

This maintenance release addresses some mainframe compatibility issues, bug fixes, and specific platform problems. Product changes include:

- In a major new product feature, COLOR is now supported in both character and GUI mode. This is implemented identically to the VM/CMS editor, through the SET and QUERY COLOR commands. SET COLOR also supports 3270-style highlighting features. Note that support of the color and highlighting features is dependent on the terminal emulator program used to execute uni-XEDIT. All emulators may not support all features. We have tested and recommend the dtterm, Hummingbird HostExplorer, and TeraTerm terminal emulators.
- uni-XEDIT now reads and processes the REXX program stack on entry. This corresponds to the functionality of xe under the VM/CMS operating system. Under 2.15, the Extended license is not required if stacked commands are not REXX language commands.
- Support for the Linux on S/390 platform.
- GUI mode is now supported on the Linux Intel platform. This support requires that the openmotif and xfree86 packages be installed on the Linux machine.
- Bug fixes: to correct a problem with use of hex '00' when SET HEX ON, and to force screen updates during macro execution.
- uni-FLIST 1.70 is included with this release. The Extended license is no longer required to run flist.
- The license manager is now changed so that it does not enforce a delay in using uni-XEDIT after the license manager is started.
- The xe -V option now displays support information regarding license management.
